



Hisarcıklioğlu: “The Soma disaster has struck at our hearts”

The aid campaign spearheaded by TOBB for the families of the workers who lost their lives at the Soma disaster has accumulated a total of 16,838,164 TRY with the support of chambers/exchanges as well as independent institutions, business people and citizens. A large portion of the population, setting aside from their allowances or their pensions,

displayed sensitivity to the plight of the families of those who lost their lives in Soma.

On the 27th of June, 2014, TOBB President M. Rifat Hisarcıklioğlu presented the cheque for the sum of the collected donations to the Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdoğan to be relayed to the Prime Ministry Disaster and Emergency

Management Directorate.

Presenting the cheque to the Prime Minister Erdoğan, TOBB President M. Rifat Hisarcıklioğlu expressed his wishes to never be subjected to such grief again; stating that the nation has once again shown its ability to stand united in solidarity in times of hardship, expressing his gratitude to everyone who contributed.

TOBB PRESIDENT M. RİFAT HİSARCIKLIOĞLU:
“Turkey needs a new growth model”

Giving the opening speech of TOBB’s 70th Financial General Assembly, TOBB President M. Rifat Hisarcıklioğlu stated that, looking back at 2013 as the private sector, they see a promising outlook and that Turkey is in need of a new growth model, listing the necessary reforms for rapid growth as:

- Tax reform,
- Industry strategy to reduce current deficit,
- Employment incentives,
- Cost reduction,
- Improvements to the real sector’s work environment with banks.

2014 European Parliament election results



European citizens elected the parliament members who will represent them in the European Parliament, the 8th time since 1979. A democratic platform wherein the main political trends of 28 EU member states, the European Parliament's 751 newly elected members were determined during the elections taking place between the 22nd and 25th of May, 2014.

The lowest participation

ratio of 43% since 1979 was observed during the last elections in 2009; this figure was not improved greatly with only 43.09% attendance in the 2014 elections. Despite joint candidates of political parties, campaigned throughout Europe, and even being held alongside local elections of various countries, the lack of significant change in participation is noteworthy.



New approaches to the 1915 Armenian Deportation assessed at TOBB ETU

The "New Approaches to the Armenian Deportation in Nearing Its Centennial Anniversary" panel was held at the TOBB University of Economy and Technology (ETU). Speaking at the opening of the panel, journalist/author Taha Akyol emphasized that Turkey has been slow in addressing the Armenian Issue, "Publications consistent with scientific criteria which support Turkey's thesis need to increase."

During his speech at the opening of the panel, Foreign Affairs Ministry Research and Security Director General, Ambassador Tunç Üğdül stated that Turkey understands and appreciates the hardships and pain suffered by Armenians during the deportation. Emphasizing, however, that this cannot be defined as genocide, Ambassador Üğdül stated that Armenians, in defending their theses, only take into consideration their own collective national memories.

"The Erasmus+ Program will increase cooperation between business and education communities"
